**Participant Engagement:**

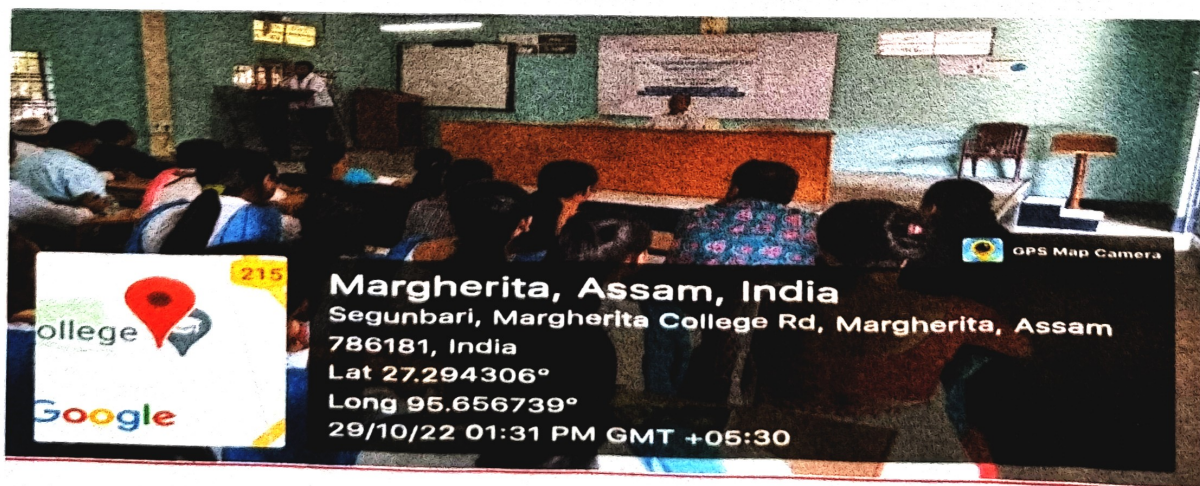

**Conclusion:**




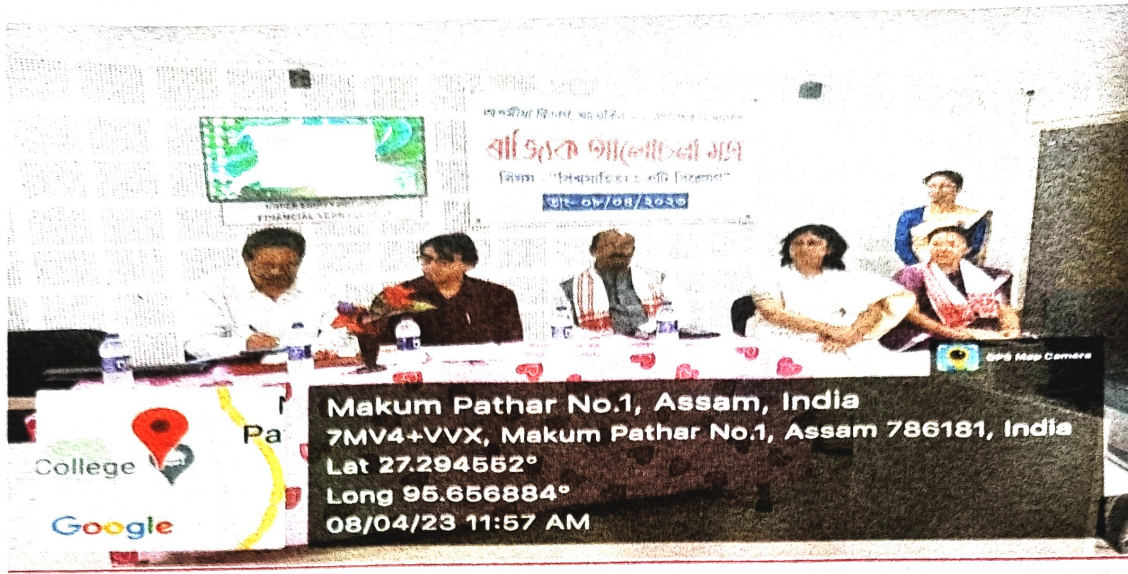
## **Participant Engagement:**

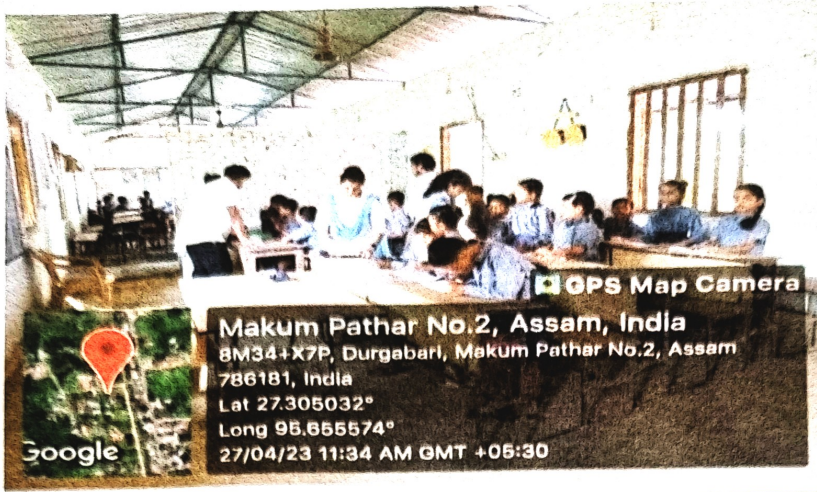

Date: 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2023

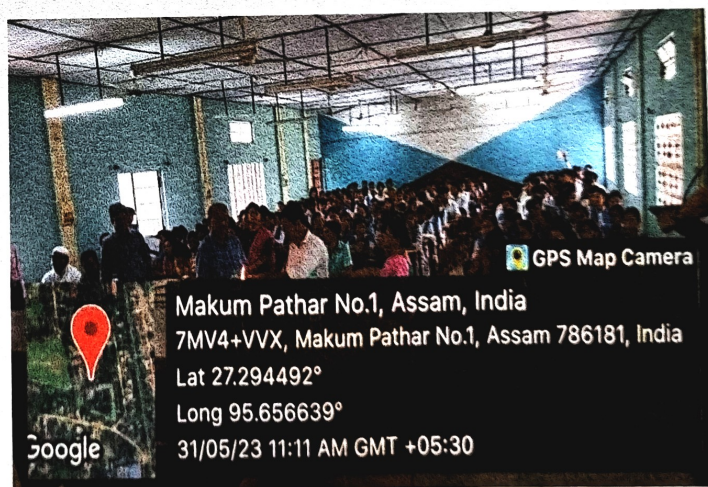

## Audience Feedback

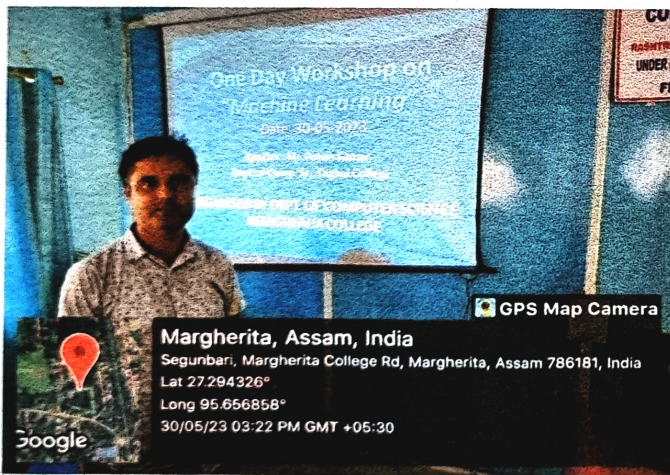

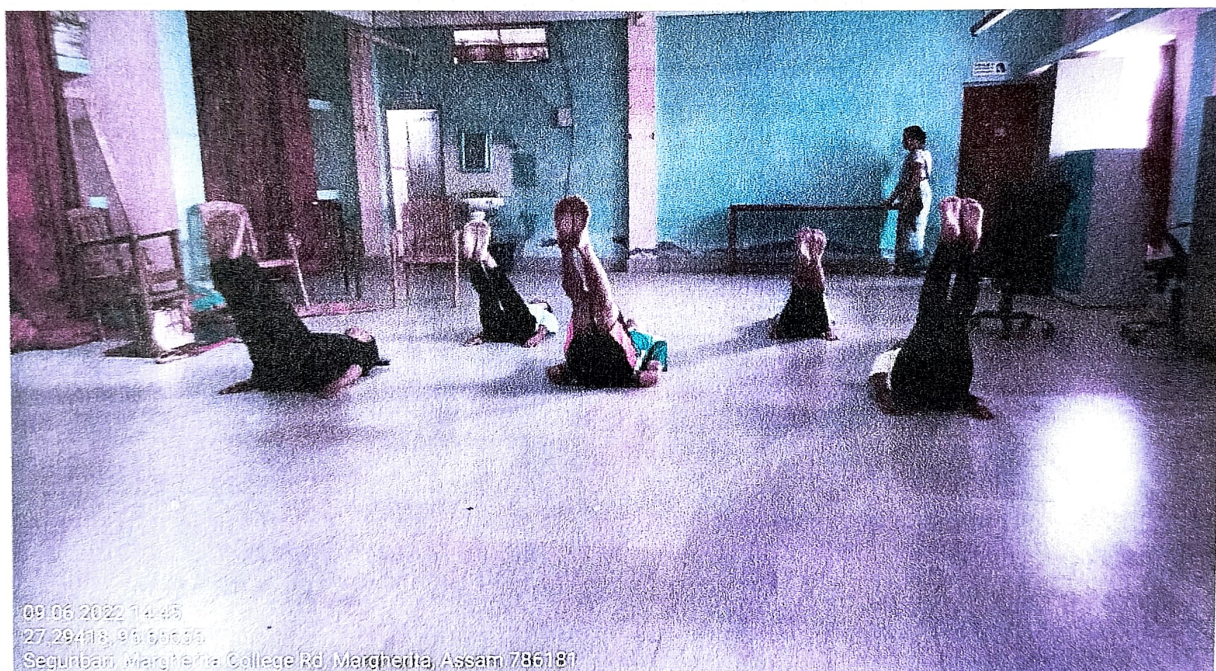
