**Outcome:**

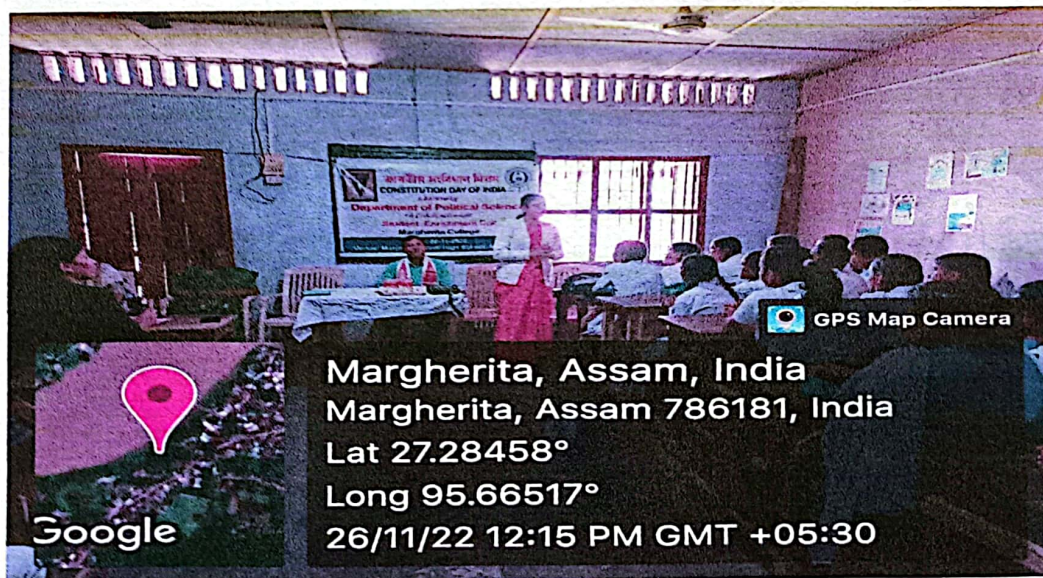

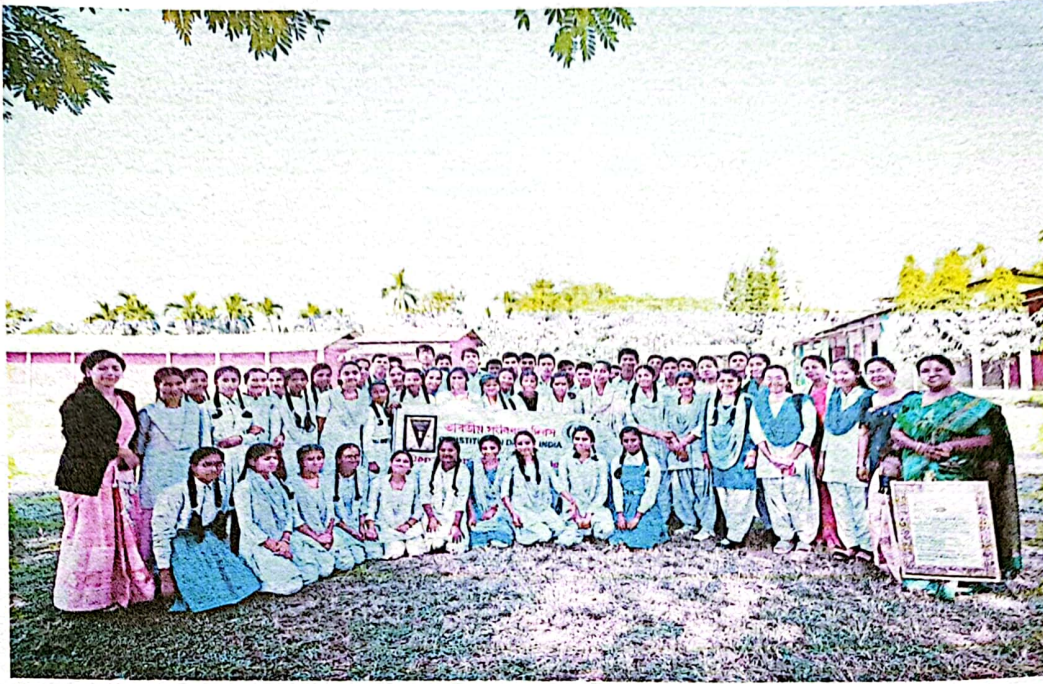
**Conclusion:**

### Outcome:

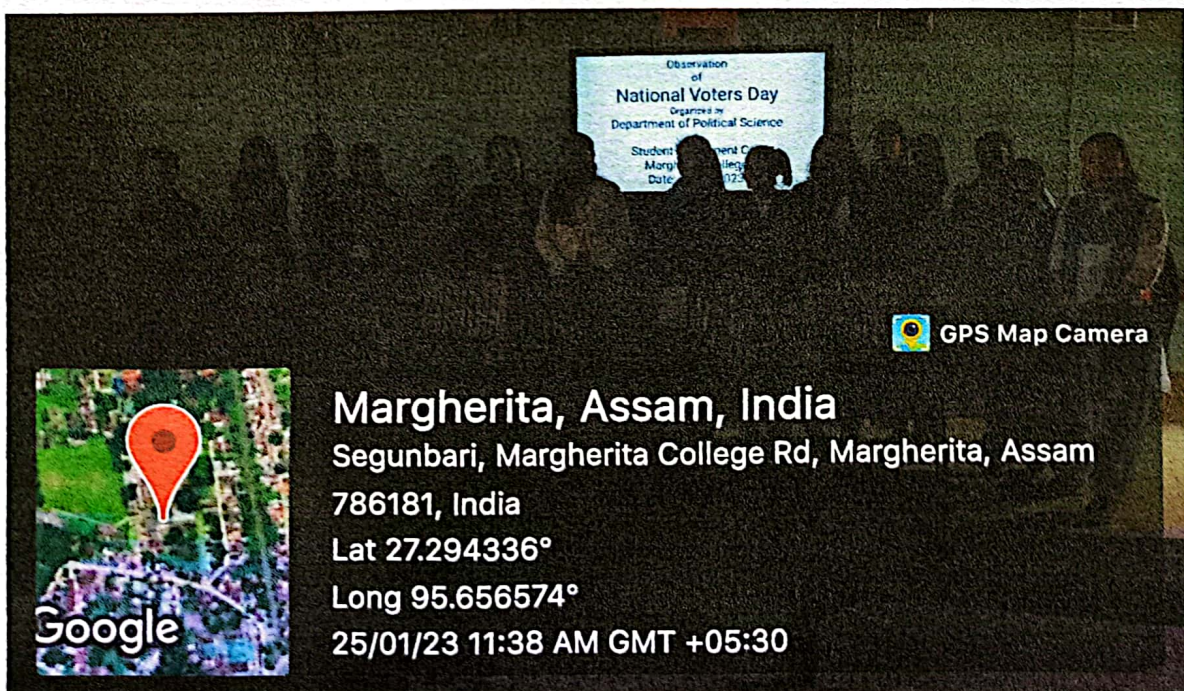

**Conclusion:**


The observance of the International Day of Forest by the Eco Club in collaboration with the Department of Political Science at Margherita College was a meaningful initiative.



