Margherita College is steadfast in translating the principles, rights, duties, and responsibilities of Indian citizens, as enshrined in the Constitution of India, into concrete actions. In various facets of its academic and non-academic operations, including the teaching-learning process, examinations, evaluation, admissions, and appointments, the college strives to instill a strong sense of duty and responsibility among both its students and faculty.

The institution adopts a zero-tolerance approach towards ragging, ensuring that the campus remains entirely free from this practice. Numerous activities that involve a substantial number of students are organized to commemorate significant events such as Voter's Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Constitution Day, Women's Day, and Human Rights Day. Furthermore, the college actively engages in planning and executing diverse activities and measures aimed at actualizing the values and principles within the campus. Ragging free zone:

STOP RAGGING!

Under Section 3 of the Assam Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, ragging in any educational institution is prohibited and no person shall commit, abet, propagate or participate in ragging in any educational institution.

WHAT IS RAGGING ?

"Ragging" means either display of power or authority or conduct or doing of any act which causes, directly or indirectly, to cause social, physical or psychological injury, raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to any student in any educational institution, and includes -

- (i) teasing, abusing of, playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such student, or
- (ii) asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly do.

PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING

Whoever commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging in any educational institution shall be punished u/s 4 of the Assam Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998 with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months or with fine which may extend to thousand rupees or with both.

As per section 5 of the Act, any student convicted under section 4 shall be expelled from the educational institution to which he belongs or to which he is admitted in any other educational institution during that period.

Outcome:

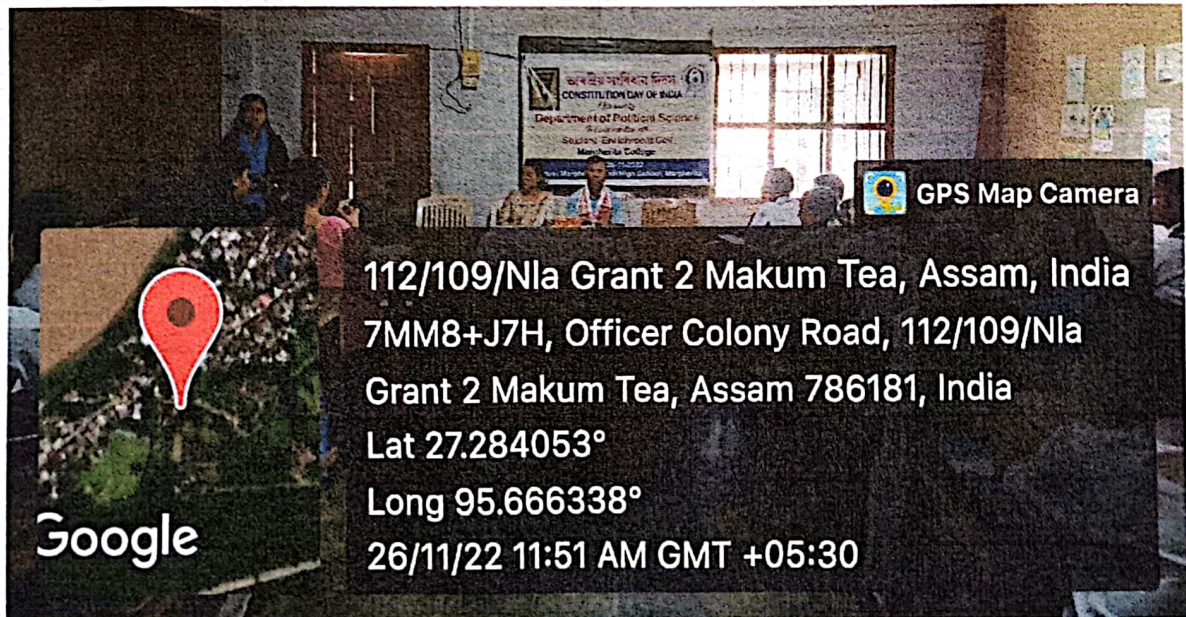
The program successfully achieved its objective, as evident from the active participation of students and the valuable feedback provided by the participants at the conclusion of the event.

Key Takeaways:

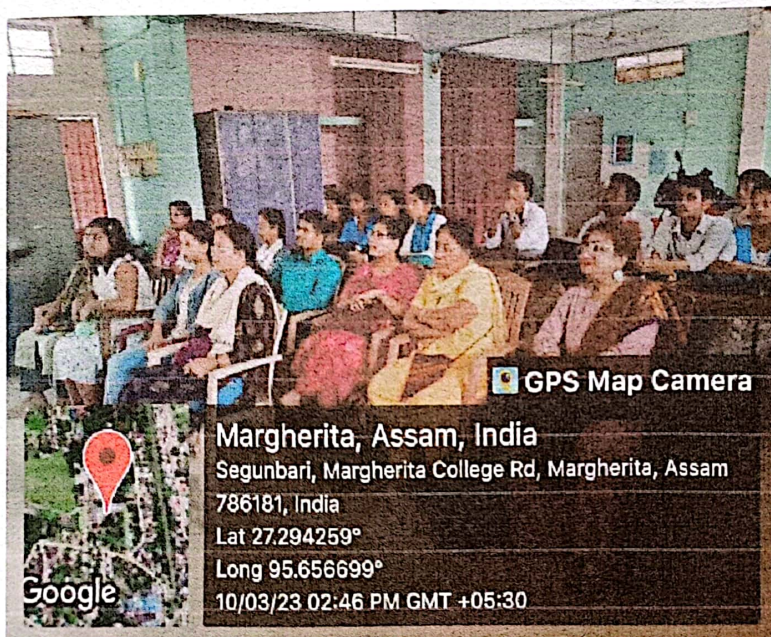
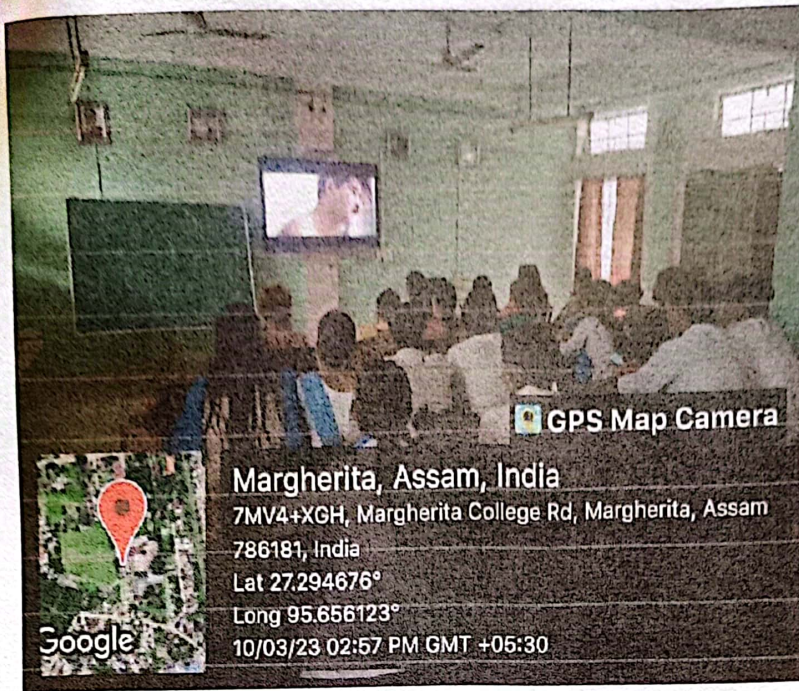

Organised by: NSS Unit, Margherita College.


