
#### 1.Stakeholder: Student


The students are the very important stakeholders of any Education institution. Participation of the students plays an important role in internal and external quality assurance of the institution. Online feedback is collected from our students through Google Forms. A set of 15 questions are put with different intensity of responses. Total number of students response received is 372. The response is contributed by students having honours. The students respondent belong to the department of English, Zoology, Sociology, Botany, Assamese, Economic, Marketing, Education, History, Political Science. The analysis is conducted on total responses from the stream of Arts, Science and Commerce from all the Semesters (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th).








1. The course/syllabus has a balance between theory and practice. 372 responses




2. The course has the capacity to develop skills and attitude towards democratic life.  $_{\rm 372\,responses}$ 




3. The objective and goal of the curriculum are well defined.




4. The course/syllabus of the subject taught increase interest knowledge and perspective in the subject area.








#### 7. Learners centered methods are applied in evaluation of student's progress. $\ensuremath{\mathtt{372}}\xspace$ responses














#### 12.Excellent learning atmosphere exist in the College campus.



#### **1.3 Observations:**

Out of the 372 responses,70.9% came from Arts,20.1% came from Science and 9% came from Commerce

Out of the 372 responses,26.9% came from  $1^{st}/2^{nd}$  Sem students,39% came from  $3^{rd}/4^{th}$  Sem students and 33% came from  $5^{th}/6^{th}$  Sem students.

Majority of the students (67.7%) agree that the course has a balance between theory and practice. However, 23.1% students are neutral in their opinion.

68.8% of the students agree that the course has the capacity to develop skills and attitude towards democratic life.

Majority of the responses (71.2%) agree that the objective and goal of the curriculum are well defined.

77.4% students agree that that the syllabus of the subject taught increased interest, knowledge and perspective in the subject area.

Approximately half of the total responses (51.1%) agree that the course taught can provide job in the market.

(57%) of the students agree that academic flexibility (choice for courses from other departments) are available.26.3% responses are neutral in this regard.

(59%) of the responses agree that Learners' Centred method are applied in evaluation of students' progress.

Less than the majority (42.5%) of the responses agree that the ICT facilities in the college are adequate & satisfactory.

(71%) of the students agree that the reference material is provided by the teachers.

Vast majority (84.7%) students agree that Sessionals are conducted as per syllabus coverage and in accordance with the academic calendar of the Dibrugarh University.

Half of the responses (50.3%) agree to the question that sufficient number of books are available in the college library.

(53%) of the students agree that learning atmosphere exist in the college campus.

Again 72% of the responses agree that extension programs are carried out by the college by various wings like NCC, NSS.

Less than the majority of the students (46.2%) agree that the overall facilities available in the college are good. (22.3%) agree that the overall facilities available in the college is very good. Only 7% of the students agree that the overall facilities in the college is excellent.

#### **Suggestions**

There occur diverse answer/suggestions to Q. No.15, "If given a chance what is the one change you would like to bring in the college?"

Most of the suggestions related to curriculum demand-

- a smart classroom,
- more ICT facilities in the College campus,
- an improved library facility with more number of books on the part of Curriculum.
- Conduction of more Seminar, group discussion and debates round.
- More interaction between teacher and students
- Students' progress must be checked.










The University course committee incorporates my suggestions regarding changes in the syllabus. <sup>25 responses</sup>




The course curriculum is well designed.



The syllabus has a good design between theory and application.




The prime objectives and course outcomes are effectively addressed in each unit.  $25\,\mathrm{responses}$ 




High quality resources are available for the syllabus.

## 2.3: Observations

Teachers from Dept. of Bengali, Commerce, English, Hindi Physics, Pol. Science, Sociology and Zoology have contributed their responses to the feedback structure.

52% of the teachers agree that they have the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate modification of the syllabus through proper forum.

68% of teachers disagree that they have contributed to the curriculum/syllabus development. However, only 12% of the responses agree the question.

Only 32% responses agree that the University Course Committee incorporates their suggestions regarding changes in syllabus. Majority (52%) disagree to the question.

The course curriculum is well developed is maximally responded (92%).

That the syllabus has a good design between theory and application is also agreed by maximum (84%).

88% of the responses agree that the prime objectives and course outcomes are effectively addressed in each unit.

52% of the responses disagree that High Quality Resources are available for the syllabus. Only 36% responses agree to the question.

68% of the responses agree that the curriculum design is contemporary and focus on employability.

#### 2.4: Suggestions

The teacher fraternity has given diverse suggestions about the syllabus:

- Most of them have laid emphasis to the shortage of time in comparison to the vastness of the syllabus.
- More job oriented syllabus must be designed.
- More option for applied and practical resources must be included.
- Vocational Education must be included in the syllabus
- High quality resources including e-books must be made available
- The syllabus load must be reduced.
- More local issues must be included in the syllabus
- The syllabus must be changed from time to time.








## Year of passed out




<u>Observation</u>: From the above figure it is found that the batch 2021-2022 contributed 28 responses out of the total 40 responses constituting 47.5 %.




 $\underline{Obsevation:}$  The above graph indicate that 75% responses agree that the curriculum is relevant for employability.

The curriculum is relevant for innovative thinking. 40 responses




<u>Observation:</u> 72.5% of the total responses agree that the curriculum is relevant for innovative thinking.

The curriculum is effective in skill oriented human resources. 40 responses




<u>Observation</u>: The above graph indicates that 65% of the total responses agree that the curriculum is effective in skill oriented human resources.
