Global Challenges in Higher Education and Margherita College



The Margherita College Newsletter have been published since September, 2005. The last Newsletter was published in October, 2008. This issue of the Newsletter is the outcome of the yet another modest attempt on the part of the present editors after a gap of three years. In this issue, efforts has been made to record the major events occurred at the college and the major achievements made by it during the period.

The for gone period of three years was quite significant and eventful in the context that the period happened to fall under the 11th Financial Plan period that placed the top priority to education and brought about a number of reforms in the education sector of the country, many of which are fundamental in nature. The major among those are – quantum jump in the allocation of funds to education, reforms of the Regulatory Authorities, reforms of Deemed Universities, reform in Quality Assessment Mechanism, Internationalisation of Higher Education and reforms of qualification framework for vocational and legal education and so on.

Higher Education system in India is said to be the largest in the world – with about 26,478 institutions providing higher education. This include Universities, Deemed Universities, Colleges and Business schools. In comparison, according to the Ernst and Young Edge, 2011 report, in 2010, the U.S.A had only 6,706 higher education schools and China had 4,000. The national commission on population has projected that the approximately 50% of the total population will be in age group of 15-25 years by the year 2016. In the next 15 years the vast population of India will enter the working age group which will lead to increase in the productive activities and also savings rate. The global demographic profile in future will lead to shortage of productive work-force globally, but India will experience a surplus. Thus, India possesses enough potentials to be a knowledge superpower or knowledge economy if its human capital is properly groomed and harnessed.

Many weaknesses are observed in Indian education system. 25% of its population still illiterate. Only 7% of its population makes to the higher education. Gross enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education is far below the ratio of several other countries. India's GER was only 12% in 2010, while it was 23% in China, 34% in Brazil, 57% in UK, 77% in both Australia and Russia and 83% in the U.S. The quality standards of Indian education institutions vis a vis the other peer nations are questionable. In the world ranking of universities by Quacquarelli Symonds in 2010, only one Indian educational institution appears in the list out of 200 world renowned universities, while 53 institutions are in the U.S. According to Webo metrics ranking for 2011, while no Indian University appears in the list, there are 99 U.S. Universities included. This essentially shows India need to develop centre for excellence of global standards.

With the globalisation and under WTO regime, "commodification" of education and educational services has takes place and are tradable in the market. It denotes free flow of knowledges, export / import of educational services, skilled human resouces, across the national border. Development in informations and communications technology as well as 'internet' has accelarated the process. Quality is the cardinal principle and yardstick under such environment. Thus the globalisation, has brought both challanges and opportunities to the Indian higher educational institutions. For a country like India, Where 25% of the populations are still illiterate, and with its low GER, lower access avenues to higher education, lack of qualities among the educational institutions, in respect of quality standards, the globalisation is a big challange. It is a challange to Indian colleges and Universities, in particular to generate globally competitive human resources in different fields.

Margherita college is one of the prominent institution of higher education in the district of Tinsukia, Assam. The college has thrived to be an ideal educational institutions since its establishment and to cater to the academic needs of the people in the area. The college has fulfilled all the basic requirements of higher educational institution prescribed by UGC, such as infrastructure, qualified teaching staffs etc. There has been a continuous effort to improve its quality stardards. The teachers/scholars of the college have been able to acquire M. Phil, Doctoral and Post-doctoral degrees – under its quality control initiative. It has also been able to produce research guides and meritorious students. The college, now takes pride having been ranked among the top 5 colleges under Dibrugarh University, A number of workshops, seminars both national and regional have been organised by the college.

The college cannot be complacent with its achievements so far made. Lots of hard works, plans are yet to be done to upgrade its quality to a global standards. The college should achieve not only excellent results of its students but should also ensure the employability of their products and generate good citizens. However, a concerted team efforts with a good leadership, the target is achievable.
